Maestro Ughi, in both roles of director and soloist, will perform with the Philharmonic Orchestra of Rome, performing music by Mozart, Boccherini, Saint-Saëns, Massenet, Bizet.

Israel is the opening stage of a concert tour that will touch also Egypt, Vietnam and Greece, focusing location of the highest artistic and cultural value, chosen as a universal heritage of humanity.
